Project Description: The Wood River Land Trust proposes work on the Big Wood River, located approximately 3000-feet downstream of the Broadford Road Bridge. This project involves nine private properties, some within Bellevue city limits. The proposed plan is to connect two historical side channels, regrade and revegetate the western bank through the reach, and install wood debris jams for bank stabilization.
